

Natural Beauty

The Burren National Park is a place of great natural beauty. In 2011 the Burren and Cliffs of Moher Geopark gained Global Geopark status. Sometimes the best way to experience a landscape is to immerse yourself in it. Foraging


Experiences out of the Ordinary



The push to bring sustainability to the forefront of our industry is evident in the Shannon Region. We're home to Ireland's only two carbon neutral hotels. In 2020, Limerick city was awarded the European Green Leaf. And at the end of 2018, Limerick was delighted to make its first entry onto the Global Destination Sustainability Index (GDS-Index). As a conference bureau, we work closely with GreenHospitality.ie and Fifty Shades Greener and are constantly striving to innovate and improve on new ways to be greener than before.



Carbon Neutral Hotel

The fabulous Falls Hotel and Spa situated near the beautiful Cliffs of Moher and Burren UNESCO Geopark is leading the way towards a greener future having received the GreenMark Carbon Neutral12 Cert from Green Hospitality Ireland. They are the first



hotel in the country to generate their own electricity through hydro power from the river that runs alongside the hotel. This, combined with the planting of hundreds of trees on the grounds of the hotel and changing over to BioLPG gas along with many other initiatives, has reduced the hotels carbon emissions by 90% in five years.

GDS Index

We participate annually in the Global Destination Sustainability Index. The GDS-Index is a collaborative business initiative created to help Destinations, Convention Bureaux, Event Planners and Suppliers drive the adoption and recognition of sustainable practices in their regions and in the global events industry. This year we plan look forward to working collaboratively with

our tourism trade partners to drive the adoption of sustainable business tourism practices and improve our overall performance.

European Green Leaf

Limerick was awarded the European Green Leaf for 2020. The European Green Leaf Award (EGLA) is open to towns and cities with between 20,000 and up to 100,000 inhabitants, to recognise and promote their efforts towards better environmental management and outcomes. Limerick was commended for its ongoing investments leading to improved air quality and noise

levels in the city. Limerick is currently transforming itself into

Ireland's first digital city, integrating several public services, creating smart homes and buildings, energy districts and smart neighbourhoods. The city is effectively

managing its air quality thanks to the acquisition of particle and gas monitors, while also encouraging people to leave their cars at home by providing better cycling, walking and public transport infrastructure with the aim of reducing transport emissions.

The resort has its own well and waste-water treatment plant on-site, which means it is entirely self-sufficient. An organic garden was created in the grounds of the hotel to supply the kitchen with the freshest and most natural ingredients possible. Shortly after the land was converted into a certified organic farm, produce from Mary's Organic Garden and the farm can be found on the breakfast table, in a host of dishes at Timmy Macs Bistro, as drink ingredients and garnishes served in Dicks Bar and as the inspiration behind Fielding's of Adare. All food-waste is composted and used for Mary's Organic Garden and the organic farm, both of which are home to trees planted as part of the resort's carbon offset programme.


